

## Nature Trails

The Nature Study Area trails are easy to walk but they are not designed for strollers and wheelchairs. *(People with strollers or wheelchair users may find that part of the main trail/service road provides access to portions of the Nature Area.)*

Trails are reserved for pedestrians. Because the Nature Study Area is managed to protect the native wildlife, horses and bicycles are not allowed, nor are dogs permitted anywhere in the Nature Area.

Each trail offers a unique experience of the varied habitats in this preserve, where you'll pass many varieties of native plants and maybe catch a glimpse of some of the wild creatures who call this area home.

### Did you know?

This Nature Preserve is a designated "Watchable Wildlife" area.



The interpretive signs along each trail provide information about the natural history of the lower American River and its riparian habitats.

Each season and each time of day has something special to offer. As you walk the trails listen for bird songs, watch for animal tracks, smell the freshness of rain and the aroma of summer plants. Discover, observe, and enjoy!
