## Directions to Carlton Farms at Drummond's Field in James City County

3516 Mott Lane, Williamsburg, VA 23185

From New Kent, King William, King and Queen, points west of Williamsburg:

Take I-64 East to exit 234 (Route 199). At the top of the exit ramp, bear to the right. Follow Route 199 for about 4 miles to the first traffic light at Route 5 (John Tyler Highway). Turn right on Route 5. Follow Route 5 for about 4 miles. Turn left onto Greensprings Road (Route 614). Turn right into Drummond's Field on Mott Lane. Carlton Farms will be on your left.

From Hampton, York, Poquoson, Suffolk, Isle of Wight, Gloucester and points east of Williamsburg:

Take I-64 West to exit 242A (Route 199 West). Follow Route 199 for about 4 miles to the fifth traffic light at Route 5 (John Tyler Highway). Turn left on Route 5. Follow Route 5 for about 4 miles. Turn left onto Greensprings Road (Route 614). Turn right into Drummond's Field on Mott Lane. Carlton Farms will be on your left.
