July 8 – Story Time Come relax and enjoy some nature tales. The event is recommended for children and the young at heart.

July 14 – Pond Paint Settle in to a spot in the shade and take time to notice all beauty of the Nature Center Pond. Using water colors and water from the pond, create unique pieces of art to take home! Art supplies and encouragement provided.
