July 6—*American River the Beautiful*: Come celebrate the beauty of the American River this 4th of July weekend. Join a Naturalist for a walk and learn about this historic and beautiful waterway.

July 7—*Pond Paint*: Snag a spot in the shade and take time to notice all the beauty of the Nature Center Pond. Using water color paints and water from the pond, create unique pieces of art to take home! Art supplies and encouragement provided, but not instruction.

July 13—*Fawn Frolic*: It's fawn season! Get out in the preserve in hopes of "spotting" one of these secretive babies!

July 14—*Whoooo's There? Owls!*: Meet an owl and take an eye-opening look at these amazing hunters.

July 20—*Beat the Heat!*: Take time to appreciate trees for the shade they provide by enjoying a leisurely morning walk on the preserve trails. Join a Naturalist as you watch for deer, hawks, woodpeckers and much more before the afternoon heats up.

July 21—*Leapin' Lizards*: Skinks, blue bellies and alligator lizards, oh my! Come meet some resident animals and find out what makes these cold-blooded critters so amazing. Then join a Naturalist for a walk in the preserve in search of these reptiles!

July 27—*Bark Rubbing*: Come explore the varieties of trees found in the Nature Center's village and create your own colorful bark rubbing art. Learn how each tree's bark pattern is the key to identifying the many types found in this area.

July 28—*Hawk Talk*: Do you wonder which hawks you are seeing in your neighborhood? Come learn some tips on identifying the most common hawks in the area and get up-close with the Nature Center's resident hawk.
