

3 Rattlesnakes 1:30pm	4	5	6	<p>The summer solstice occurs when a planet's rotational axis, in either northern or southern hemispheres, is most inclined toward the star that it orbits. Donations welcomed! Space is limited – sign-ups are taken the day of the event.

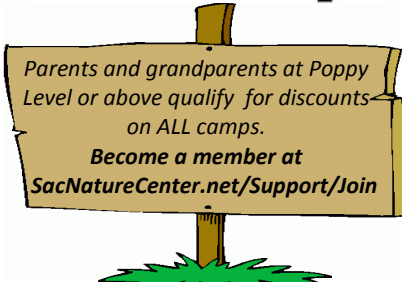
