

Learn about each of their unique journeys and how they became an educational ambassador for the Nature Center. *This program will be a presentation.</p>	<p>March 8—*Wild About Cats*: Come hear a Naturalist talk about our native wild cats. Learn all about Bobcats, Mountain Lions and the animals they love to hunt. *This program will be a presentation.</p> 
<p>March 14—*Invasive Invaders*: At Effie Yeaw we have a few non-native plant and animal species that have taken up residency in the preserve. Learn about the history of a few of these trespassers, their role in the current ecosystem and what people are doing to lessen the issues that come along with these invasive invaders. *This program will be a hike.</p>	<p>March 15—*Raptors of the River*: Invite your friends to become raptor experts on local birds of prey. Program includes PowerPoint presentation, specimens and live raptors.
