May 5 – Under the Oaks Our mighty oak trees provide food and shelter for many animals and insects. Learn how to identify the three species of oak trees found in the Nature Pre- serve, and who may be living in them. Come nose to nose with a few of our resident animals, hear their story and learn all about what makes them unique!
