

November 3 – Slithering Snakes Learn all about our legless friends who live along the American River and get a visit from one of our reptilian animal ambassadors.	November 4 – Land of Many Oaks The acorns and leaves of the oak trees are falling all around us. Learn all about different species of oak trees and about some of the mammals, birds, reptiles and insects that call them home.
November 10 – Fall Colors Create colorful fall art by making leaf rubbings of the leaves found in the Nature Center's village area. Have fun while learning how leaf shape and size help in identifying trees.	November 11 - Salmon Stroll Learn about the life cycle of this amazing long distance swimmer and take a stroll to the river to see them spawning.
November 17 – Birding for Families Bring the family out for a birding and nature walk led by a Naturalist and special guest guides from the Sacramento Audubon Society.
