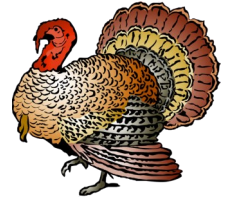

Learn all about different species of oak trees and about some of the mammals, birds, reptiles and insects that call them home.</p>
