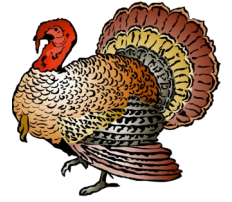

**\*This program will be a hike.**

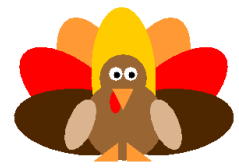
