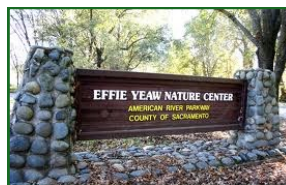

Winter solstice occurs for the Northern Hemisphere in December and for the Southern Hemisphere in June.</p> <p>It is often considered the "extreme of winter."
