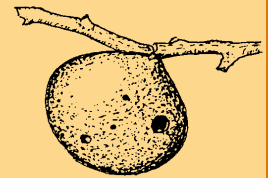
October 3—Going Batty: Explore the mysteries of bats! Discover why these creatures are so misunderstood.
