

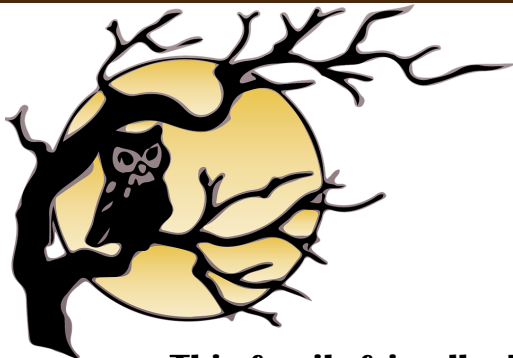


Join us every Saturday & Sunday for educational programs!
